Cloudy mild raining a little through day  
 Willie cultivated turnip land also rest of orange  
 corn etc land that we didn't - rib up using 4 horses  
 Bella and I tied up the raspberry bushes to stakes  
 and I plowed the garden etc. Mrs Quaine in  
 to see if I could help her with her turnips which she  
 has not got up yet for Blacks man Willie  
 I went down with team to help her but  
 came back on account of rain and wet.

25

Wednesday

Rained heavy last night misty 9 AM cleared  
 off PM but cloudy almost warm to-day. We  
 filled up some of pond in N & W with team  
 and scraper taking most of earth from high  
 ridge along fence. Willie hove up some turnips  
 for Mrs Quaine in PM. Mary down  
 town 9 AM got at Armstrongs on aft. \$4.88  
 also 10 lbs grain pd.

Thursday

cloudy and sunny warm very windy  
 Willie plowed rape land splitting the drills  
 in AM and in PM he hauled in turnips  
 for Mrs Quaine aided by Roy Black  
 I worked at filling in pond all day.  
 Jennie Sandham and 3 children Nellie Milne  
 and 2 children Jennie & Donald and Earn Sandham  
 up for tea. Bus came for them in evening.

Friday

Colder to-day windy cloudy. I worked at pond all day Willie  
 at plowing rape land. Sold 100 lbs turnips to Smith Lumber Merchant  
 Willie home at night for papers.
