Made an Agreement with Elias Stout to haul from Mr Hamiltons Mill to my House 500 feet 1 1/2 Inch Boards & 500 feet 1 Inch to
Pay him 26/- ^{Feb 26th paid E. Stout his part (butler 9/6 Aug 1794)} Paid Geo Havens 6/6 in part of 13/-
Jan^y 12th

Paid Lambert Aker 8/- for a boar in dispute between him & myself. to be brought home by him

Paid Mr Joseph Edwards 40/- in part of acct.

Jan^y 28th

No Snow on the Ground & fine Weather from 21st the 31st a little snow, which went off: Snowed 24th a little went away 7th 29th

Mr Daniel Ross's House burnt down, his two sons kept from school and John M^r Muckey left school.

Bruised my Fingers ^{30th} Very bad

Feb^y 8th

My Heifer (Brookle) Calved a Bull which died 3 day after. (a cow died by eating its Litter)

Paid Mr Still 5/8 & some time ago 20/- for breaking Glass
March 2nd

Sunday it snow'd all day on

Wednesday Mar 5th

Last Night was & this Morning was the Hardest Frost I ever felt.

N.B. Froze my fingers ^{this morn} while I was Fording the ice above five Minutes from the Mill

Monday 10th March

Rained which carried away the Snow

8th March

Elias Stout received 1/2 Ton Hay £2 10.0 toward payment of shingles which he and his Father has promised to get

Thursday 20th March

This was a very warm day the Thermometer was at 93 & the hottest day last summer was at 108 Sunday 23rd

My Cow (Black-face) Calved a Bull (call'd March)

Mar 31st

The Greatest storm this Year Snow and Rain all day April 8th

My Cow (Sruspe) Calved a Bull (call'd Hunter)

April 17th

The Mipsauga arrived the first Vessel this Year

26th April

The Simcoe a New Merchant Vessel arrived at the Wharf at the Landing for the first time

26th

Recd ~~from~~ the Mill 1 1/2 Bushels Wheat from Joseph Brown for Writing a Bill of Sale & Mortgage

28th

Paid Wm Havens for hewing beams 22/- by arrowed at Hamiltons
