Dangers of Saline Injection.

The *British Medical Journal* says that saline injections, as at present administered, are by no means free from risk, especially when they are large. Neither centrifuging, filtering through cotton-wool or bacterial filters, nor boiling, is sufficient to prevent the fever that follows saline injections. It is claimed that distillation in a sterile Jena retort of all water used in the preparation of saline solutions, followed by immediate injection, is at present the only reliable method of insuring that no fever follows the injection.
