here Fernandez fishing last night got 12
Caspian went down Rained to night
Old George the 3rd Birth Day used to be
kept up for a long time 5th Fine
Working at the wire fence West Wind
Fernandez and Leander to Summerstown with
2 Boats for oil 6th On this Day of the North
for John Mc Donald departed Harrowing
the Barley Peice sowed 4 Bushels of
Windy Fernandez to Lancaster Barley
11 of the cows calved Fernandez to Lancaster

East Wind put the Plough through the rest
of the corn Rained making Ribs for Leander
Boat Fernandez came Heard David Fraser
was very poorly Bought Ink Mucilage
Medicine not very well Leander crossed
For nails for the Ribs of the Boat very heavy
Rain Thunder and Lightning Bought Tea 8th Windy
Making Ribs Piling some Stove Wood Washing
the Wool 9th County Mary's Birth Day 1813
This is the Day for the Bob Johnson's Fight
June W Wind Fixing the Boats with Ribs
Leander crossed for wrought Iron for the Ribs
Hoed some Rows of Corn piling stove Wood
Lots of Boats going to Day 10th Fine W Wind
Fixing and Painting the Boat Fixing fence
Hoing Corn put the Wool in Bags 4 lbs
Leander crossed Heard Randolph's wife
was not well 11th St Barnabas Day
Here Day Ed Renshaw and Mont here
Fissy went to see Randolph wife
Leander to church 12th Fine a Lot of
Yewlers 4 Boats of them on the North
side Mr Mulhern and his Uncle from
Ohio Mr Ed Douquet Louise Basell and they
brought me to a Drop of Good Stuff
