 that were down. our machine needs the Boxes filled
 and we didnt like to run it. we got big field all
 on shocks tonight. W. fine clear
 16 Bound Oats & cut what was down. A m J B & W
 drew in 2 loads barley raskings & 2 wheat raskings
 I & Dave finished Oats. W. warm clear
 17 Moved thrasher out of old barn into new this
 morning. then drew in 7 loads peas & 2 loads Oats
 after supper. W. warm clear east wind P m
 Sunday 18 Nancy & children went to Meeting at
 Hebron I staid with my Mother she is a great
 deal better but it was rather wet for her to go
 B. D. were here P m. W. slight shower this morning
 another pretty heavy at noon
 19 Finished drawing sod Peas 8 loads & set power
 This evening J B is here again. W. close a little
 20 Thrashed 31 boxes Oats 13 boxes raskings & 63 boxes
 Treadwell wheat didnt go very well broke two
 arms. W. very warm. flies very bad
 21 Made up for lost time went very well today
 thrashed 100 bus Treadwell wheat till noon
 boys & J B pulled peas in big field P m. I & J
 brought 2 pigs from A B's W. very very close
 22 Finished pulling peas in big field A m Drew in
 Spring wheat 4 loads & 2 loads Oats P m. Dave
 thinned Globe turnips. W. very close. warm
 Mr James Metcalfe Elected by acclamation
 On the 20th Inst for Cast for R
 23 Drew in Oats below garden 15 loads & 7 loads
 out of field back of Cider house W. fine clear
 24 I got Frank show this morning W & J B drew in 2 loads
 Peas out of big field when I came back we drew in last Oats 3 loads
 behind Geler house. Drew in 12 loads Peas. Finished big field P m
 W. very warm

Sunday 25th ^{Aug} went to Meeting at Wickham's Remarks by W
 Joseph. B. Key. sermon on St Mat 18 C by P. C. went
 to J. Lehman's P m & to J B's for supper. W. pretty warm
 26 I & Nancy went to Markham & to J B's. P m J B & Dave pulled
 Crown Peas & W helped Sanderson thrash W. fine clear
 27 I & J B & Dave pulled Peas A m W helped Sanderson finish
 thrash A m. helped us pull Peas P m. W. fine clear
 28 Finished pulling Peas A m W began to draw clams
 off heap in fallows on sod Pea ground & J. B. & Dave
 drew in 4 loads Crown Peas W. fine warm clear
 29 Finished Peas 3 loads A m I & J B drew dung &
 W began to plow Pea ground P m. W. fine shower
 30 I & W plowed J B & Dave finished drawing clams
 & spreading it J B went home tonight. W. very heavy
 north wind. Cold as October a little drish rain
 31 Both plowed. Dave took share to B. D. & thinned Globe
 turnips. W. pretty cold & windy yet. clear
 Sept 1 Sunday at home. I went to Dr. M. Nancy has
 symptoms of Vomiting & Cramps or spasms. W. clear
 2 Nancy better again. I plowed in pea stubble
 nearly finished A m W. plowed in new fallows
 I skinned J. B. Co. 3 year old Netherby mare P m
 she died last night of Influenza or distemper
 & took skin to Markham to get dressed for a
 robe they thought they couldnt do it in the summer
 season so I sold it for \$1.00 W. cold. clear
 3 I finished Pea stubble till 10 o'clock then helped
 W finish new fallow till supper. Dave harrowed
 Pea ground with Dick & J. B. A. Ad. Primer
 I sowed some of new fallow ^{Treadwell} after supper
 W furrowed ^{it} out in fallow & Pea ground
 4 Finished sowing new fallow. then helped W plow Dave
 finished harrowing new fallow. W. windy. Cloudy began
 raining nicely at about 6 o'clock this evening. very get
 5 Both plowed A m. I sowed 4 bags Treadwell on west
 end of field near Hoover's P m then plowed till night
 Dave harrowed. W. rather cloudy. looks like rain
 6 Dave finished harrowing till about 10 o'clock then I helped W plow
 sold some Treadwell wheat yesterday & today @ \$1.37 per bus for seed
 W. warm fine rain last night
