and 6 Bags of Wheat for Flour, and I bought
a ram took it home. Sent 2 Lickens to Scotland
one to James Reid
Thursday 3rd one to Mary Reid

This was a fine morning Willie, John and I
killed a pig afternoon picking
apples Mrs. John Colclough and went to H. Calkburn
Friday 4th

This was a dull day I was picking apples John
cleaning out the pigs Willie was ploughing
John and I was stacking from some Corn
Saturday 5th 2

This was a dull day Mrs. and I went to
Guelph we had some showers of rain the
forenoon coming from the afternoon heavy rain and blowing
all afternoon
