Threatening Obstetric Hemorrhage.

G. Fieux (*Annales de Gyn. et d'Obs.*) placed the patient in the Trendelenburg position to combat symptoms of ischemia of the brain and found that it arrested at once and permanently the tendency to hemorrhage. After that he applied it in four additional cases. He improvised a support of a chair, face down under the mattress, the back of the chair under the patient's back. By this means the blood in the uterus and vagina falls back and acts as a tampon or plug to the bleeding surface.
