I went up to D. Allans in morning with team which we put with his on potato digger and plowed out some drills for him then brought it down. We finished our potatoes to-day 9 drills dug with Allen digger. Willie and I drove down in evening helped them put up coal stove etc at home. coal oil 1 leaves 2 gal's 44 ct

10

Saturday

Hard frost last night fine sunny AM clouded over rained a few drops PM. We finished taking in manure to-day all but half a load or so got in 8 loads, 7 other brought up the 19 sheep that were down at home pasture in PM. Willie drove in down in evening

11

Sunday

Mostly cloudy cool. Dr Waters of India spoke on medical mission work in India AM and Mr Reid of Alma and Curranock presided in evening from 2 Kings 6:17. Miss Bell was April 50

12

Monday

Very hard frost last night fine sunny day. Willie took apron of manure spreader and broken wagon tongue to Party to get fixed brought up 70 lbs coat 7 gal's up making Am 15. I plowed some of broken heat land. In PM we harrowed and picked potatoes took in rest of manure etc dug some of drills down No 2. Mary & Mrs Ritchie down town PM latter stayed down Mary got groceries Am 38 tea 7 ct 25 - Powells dinner 50 paid 50 for prints 140 got flour from Messin a/c 35 Mrs Durr called in PM
