- October 22 continued Monday forward 114914 96250
 at Scripps got Lucy shod at Hodges 25cts
 The girls went up to Arthur to-day in new buggy
 to Uncle Walls got back about 7 o'clock.
 J. Fernal and W. Graham up all day Mr Gass over
 in PM pulling and trimming turnips We got 2 loads
 down to Sekanis in PM and one put on. I drove up
 to J. Meek to see J. Johnstone if he would come
 to thrash for us he promised to come to-morrow PM.
- 23 Tuesday 1550
 Fine day sunny. J. F. and W. G. up all day
 We got ready to thrash in AM. Willie drove down
 in buggy got at Armstrongs on aft goods
 (see bill) \$3.60 got bread at Jacksons 30cts I took
 down load turnips to Sekanis in morning got ticket
 for the 3 loads 30cts cheque for them at 9cts bushel
 \$250 also for straw sold in summer \$3.00. In PM
 we thrashed, the following being here. Thrashers John
 Johnstone Jack James Johnstone. Hands W. Hamilton
 S. M. Kee. Mr Boys. Mr Gass. Mr Pick Mr Arm-
 strong. Jim Ford J. F. + W. G. Mother up in AM.
- 24 Wednesday
 Windy last night cloudy day rained about 5
 o'clock very heavy at night. We thrashed to-day till
 5 o'clock. Hands Messrs Dix, Allan, Hamilton, M. Kee.,
 Ford, Rowe, Gass, Clark, Pick, Boys, Sindale, J. F.
 W. G. Mrs Match and May over in PM evening.
- 25 Thursday
 Mostly cloudy a little sunshine and some rain.
 We finished thrashing this forenoon. They
 moved to Walls for PM Willie and Mr Gass went
 to thrashing. We had following this AM
