

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 28, 1870.

Charley has been ploughing 2 day. If nothing happens we will finish up in tomorrow. I have been myself at ditching, besides repairing up the house for winter. The weather is very beautiful now, and warm too.

Also the infant Bernard was early dedicated to the Lord and Phenoftho regarded as a servant of the Master".

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 29, 1870.

He went over to Paper Kyrnes this morning with his truck sheep, the remainder of the day Charley has been ploughing and I have been stitching.
