18 Friday. Cold. The men plowed all day.

19 Saturday. Cloudy & cold. Walter took goat to Bradell this morning. They were plowing. Walter & Vernon went to Elmira tonight.

20 Sunday. Cloudy. Snowflurries. We went to Woolwich church F. P. this morning and down to Peter Musselman's at Coestogo with Charlie Miller. We went to the Coestogo United Church this p.m. Walter, Angus, Norman and Charlie sang a quartette. We went to Elmira Evangelical church tonight.

21 Monday. Showery. Ella did her washing. The men plowed.
