I took down 9 hogs to Boharo 1420 lbs at 675 per cwt \$95.85 got paid for turps sold him in April \$4.50 wing tips 18 Fred Bowley got 14 bushels oats \$5.55. Mary down in P.M. got letter from father P. Landry at Joe telling of their arrival etc. She sent letter to Willie 2. She paid D. Webster for boiler 2.00 pot 25 got meat at Mills 25 Wm.
