Thawish in A.M. sunny and cloudy a little mist started to snow in P.M. developed into a dense blizzard of snow Rogerson came in to escape from it. We hauled up 3 loads avoid from bush in A.M. and in P.M. cut some of it with circular saw. Father went to Sulphur to-day to get his books audited. Willie drove him home from station with Frey as cutter.

Sunny day. frosty. thawing a little in sun. Willie took load cut wood down home then we brought up another load from bush to barn. In P.M. we spread 4 loads manure on No 5 with spreader. Mary down at W.F.M.S. meeting in P.M. gave 25cts help get Indian boys suit and 50cts membership fee. got stamps 10cts balance Russell up March 17cts yarn 32cts received for butter takes No 5 egg 1 day Mrs Welch 25cts We all went down to Mrs Quarries in evening Willie went home first to see father about mortgage on Edmestone 50 acres in Arthur Township as he wants \$600.00 more on it.
