- 5 no meeting to day rain & snow most of the day the largest flakes of snow fell that I saw the snow is 4 inches deep the trees are loaded with
- 6 went to the funeral of Thomas Webster he was struck with a tree that he was chopping & thrown 32 feet from the stump last Monday the Rev. Mr. Carroll preached there was 62 slaughtering & cisterns snow this afternoon
- 7 heavy North East wind with light snow & drift went to Benj's springs he began to use Cosgrove's medicine on his horse
- 8 drizzling snow most of the day cut browse for the cattle & worked a little at the house
- 9 worked in the Sugarbush cold day
- 10 De the snow is going there is a little rain too night
- 11 worked in the Sugarbush. Ad drew a few loads of dung to the place for the orchard warm day
- 12 went to the Schoolhouse very few then the Rev. Mr. Brown preached the roads very bad
- 13 worked in the Sugarbush but frost last night
- 14 Ad went to Mr. Brown's & got 200 of hay on delivery per 100 I worked in the Sugarbush
- 15 drew some dung worked in the bush I help C. Sprague to ~~work~~ at a churn
- 16 Crise at his churn Ad & Belle done 25 set of bunks some rain to day
