of Boots 4 Dollars 1 pair of Blankets 50
1 Web of Cotton Randolph and Mollwater
here Boys at Blinds Sowed Hayseed to Day

14th Stanley came Drawing Nails to the Stack
splitting Boards for Blinds Taken them
up to Douglis's Fine Day set a Trap
at the White Birch The Dredge Working
thats Broke on her 2 of Lewis here for
Butter one of those sea going vessels
went up 15th Fine Stanley Fencing the
Stacks Drawing Sand took over the Bricks
Began the North Chimney Lavinia and
Jonia crossed to Summerstown Sent
my Letter to the Editor E. V. Donnelly with
a Dollar in it for to Begin on the 16th
splitting Stove Wood Bitter Honey nut
Falling Frog Music those nights the
Black Birds in Flocks Bought 5 Spools
of Thread ^{ough Bottles} 50 cents of Sugar 2 Chimneys 16th
Raining I went up to the Upper Point
found a Cap too wet to work at the
chimney the Stack all fenced Rained
very heavy all night the Dredge to 4 Dg of Egg 72
7th Unfortunate Day Snow on the Mountains
Rained some Boarding South side some Big Flocks a
lying Duncan Cameron Passed Down Mr Lanigan
and Mr Barnhart Shot the Bull Fernandez
went up with them
