 16 Boiled Sauce. Joe drew dung Flavin's filled P.M.  
 17 Drew dung I & Flavin's filled <sup>in fine</sup> P.M. Joe went  
 to J Clark's raising P.M. I drew dung & Flavin's filled  
 W. very fine. B.C. & B.A.'s came home from  
 United States today  
 Sunday 18 at home Jane Duncan was here W. Cold  
 19 Finished drawing dung & shook apples <sup>wind</sup> A.M.  
 began digging Potatoes P.M. W. fine Cl  
 20 dug Potatoes. W. beautiful & warm  
 21 dug Potatoes. W. beautiful & warm  
 22 Finished digging Potatoes this evening. They are  
 very large & pretty good turnout. W. fine  
 white frost last night  
 23 John harrowed Potatoes ground & I & little boys  
 Picked odd Potatoes A.M. dug last of early  
 Potatoes behind barn P.M. Joe finished plowing  
 full wheat stubble A.M. Plowed a little  
 in bee ground second time P.M. Flavin's  
 spread dung P.M. W. very fine Cl  
 24 I went shooting awhile A.M. with  
 Chris W. Bush holder. not much game  
 saw one Blue R. Squirrel I shot that  
 went to B.S. P.M. & Chored Joe Plowed A.M.  
 threshed Peas P.M. W. fine Cl  
 Sunday 25 at home J.B.'s were here P.M. W. fine  
 26 I chored a.m. sang took stones girl home  
 Joe Plowed. Both Plowed P.M. W. fine warm  
 27 Both Plowed. W. fine A.M. rather cloudy P.M.  
 this is the 17<sup>th</sup> anniversary of my Marriage a little <sup>last night</sup>

28 I went to Markham <sup>Nov 1874</sup> A.M. Plowed P.M. W. cooler  
 29 Plowed. R. Jac. Wickman & wife came on a visit  
 little John Plowed a while then. W. Clear very ~~high~~  
 high wind P.M. J.H. Harris boy & girls were here today  
 30 we finished plowing Pea field second time until  
 noon then began pulling turnips P.M. W. pretty  
 cold wind Uncle Sam & Russ's were here awhile P.M.  
 31 I & little boys made 57 gals Cider & Joe threshed  
 Peas A.M. Joe pulled turnips P.M. I didn't feel well  
 Sunday Nov 1 at home B.C. & B.A. were here P.M. W.  
 squalls of snow. didn't whiten the ground  
 2 I & little boys killed a pig A.M. Joe pulled  
 turnips. I & boys helped awhile P.M. W. mild  
 3 Pulled turnips. very white frost last night  
 I quit about 3 P.M. to the tennet mason to fix oven  
 4 Pulled turnips. W. a little frost last night  
 John Bear sheet yesterday evening  
 5 Pulled turnips until about 9 O.C. when it began to rain  
 then Joe threshed Peas Flavin's came A.M. rained  
 till about 2 P.M. then finished pulling turnips  
 6 Began drawing in turnips I went to J. Ben's  
 funeral A.M. Drove with 2 waggons P.M. took  
 in 12 loads W. beautiful & Clear warm  
 & drew turnips with 2 waggons A.M. & with 1  
 P.M. took in 14 loads I pitched back in cellar P.M.  
 8 Nancy & girls went to Meeting at Hebron's boys  
 stuck with my Mother Diller's were here awhile  
 A.M. St. Lukes were here P.M. & Uncle John  
 Bush holder. B.C. were here this evening  
 9 Finished drawing in turnips & toasts I went to  
 B.S. this evening. W. fine Cl  
 10 Drew 4 cords wood out of old lunk for my  
 Mother put apples into cellar & Joe threshed  
 some Peas. I went to Cedar Grove this evening  
 W. pretty strong east wind. Cool  
 Adeline & Susanna went to wedding at J.H. Harris  
 Commaline was married today to Benj. Hower  
 our girls went with B.C. & his girls
