

I have let this lapse again for a week so these next few items will necessarily be brief and may be incomplete.

Wednesday April 22nd

I walked over home this morning to get Queen and Dad wanted me to go down to Aunt's with Lina to get some wood. And he wanted to take Joe & Queen so we didn't get home till noon as we had a little conversation with Mr. Parks who is at Aunt's most of the time working over the old papers. He had a stenographer there this morning and Aunt Alice was dictating to her. She is some friend of Aunt's from Brautfield. Aunt Alice seems very much excited, worried and upset over the whole business.

This afternoon I went up to Hervey Shand's right after dinner to tell him Herb Brooks was up at Dan Thompson's out of a job. Then I came home and drilled in the rest of my peas and it took all of the bushel I got to do it. I took the drill back and came home and harrowed over the fresh drilled piece and took the harrow back to Dave, which made me rather late. Agadonby seems to be getting more contented and like the children. Much milder today.

Thursday April 23rd

Tom Stone came into the school house which I was dusting this morning so I told him I wanted to scrape the road again. He was on his way to Jarvis but said he would come down after dinner. I spent the forenoon cleaning out the ditches in the pea field and about eleven went after my roller and brought it home. This afternoon Tom & I scraped the south end of the road and visited for a short time with old Mr. Pheasant who was fishing at Biddey's Bend. Very warm.

Friday April 24th

Tom and I scraped the north end of the road this morning and had one round to make on Fred Mison's concession after dinner. Willard Butler is putting in the crop on the Henry Mison's place. He & Charlie Chuland have bought it from Julian for \$2700 I heard. Agadonby, Harry B and I went down town this afternoon and did our trading and brought Gay home with us. Aunt and Aunt Alice hated to have her come away but they have enough to look after down there and they expected Ray to-night but he didn't come. Hot today.
