& Hattie went to Drummondville had 13^{3/4} butter @ 24
butter came to 3.30. saqr. 10 chess 17 coffee 26 tea 25
pump killer 25 gal oil 20 3yds flannel 84 castor oil
velociteer 50 socks 13 sodas 30 Peasins 10. 3.30
raining when they came home. I churned &
worked the butter at night & peeled pears. I also
pecked a chicken for supper stewed on the night
fire & threw over everything but melting off
the house turned cold in the afternoon Marjorie
baking bread. I emptied the rag box a barrel full
& two bags full got the settler out in work house
emptied the meat barrel. I was busy all day at
clearing up the wood house. & boiling pig feed
Arthur ploughing on the clover acre field
Thurs 9. ground froze this morning when I went down
to sweep & make fire. the school house something
terribly. I churned. I worked the butter for ourselves
Mrs Peab. & the children to tea. I made a cake &
starts for supper. Marjorie working at the jacket.
she put it in near the stove the other night. I went
Arthur started to plough on the pasture field
the first time a ~~barrow~~ has been burned in 20 years

Paul gone after cabbage to Stearnham got 15 heads
for 25. going to freeze hard tonight. Bright moonlight
Arthur over this evening

Friday 10. Indian Summer started today
Arthur but chared the pigs a beautiful day wind
west or south west. when I went down to ~~the~~
fire on the school house to Paul could go after
a barrel of water to teacher I pecked two chicken
for dinner a black & a plymouth rock one fried & one
stewed. they got them done in 2 hours @ 10 pm
at night they carried them in & we covered them up
from the east Marjorie took the teacher down & a set
of butter 4 lbs. @ 24. got a load of tags 5th tomorrow
stove polish 5 @ 75 on the book. she got a cap for Paul &
turkey red for Mrs Pounts quilt. I cleaned the entrals
Sat 11. a nice day but high wind I put the entrals out
on the cook washed the churn & swept before we could get
at the meat - the pig one weighed 23 7/8 the other 21 1/4
I scrubbed the barrel & their bins the entrals in
I tatted the meat & thinned some of the sausage
meat & after supper cleaned the entrals at streak
clean after I got on bed my back felt tired out
Marjorie cleaned up the front room & the dining
room & cleaned the oil cloth & aired the front room
Sun 12 sun part of the time & dull part of the
time. high wind woke like rain towards night.
Hattie came on & stayed the evening
Mon 13 raining I snowing part of the day
before it started to rain Marjorie billed our tick
