5 worked at the rack in the forenoon went to the

rain there was a fire noon this afternoon
5 planted some corn where it did not come up
the rain has done a vast amount of good
6 went to Sittens mills with our wool it is
14 miles west of Kingston we stopped at Mr Daniel
Nicols got our dinner went the mill come back to
Nicols Stopped all night there ^{by rain} went in the morn
7 - ing to Joseph Nicols to see them come to Kingston
bought 4 lbs of castor oil for the mowing machine
paid 25 cent per lb got home to night ^{for a day of expence} few dollars
8 finished the hay rack attended a meeting of the
building committee Wallace & Isabell come from

9 went to the funeral of Wm Moor he died on ^{day}
rain he was buried at Taylors there was 72 buggies a
waggon the Revd Mr Cornal preached a little
10 fixed or rather worked at the horse rake & went

11 fixed the mowing machine & got it ready Greenay
& the girls went to manage to set the foundation stone
of a new Wesleyan church here
12 began to mow & mowed in the North west corner
field the grass is very light

Gates daughter she died in Brecksville ^{at Taylors} she was buried
rain 14 finished cutting the corner field a fine shower this
afternoon raked & cocked some of the hay
