- 2 the Rev. Mr Cochran preached in the schoolhouse
3 worked at a waggon or rather a hay rack
Geordy worked at the corn
4 worked at the rack in the forenoon went to the
Station to attend a suite for sitting liquors without
license it was Mr Vincent Slack fine him 20 dollars ^{costs} &
rain there was a fine rain this afternoon

- 5 planted some corn when it did not come up
the rain has done a vast amount of good
6 went to A Siltons Mills with our wool it is
14 miles west of Kingston we stayed at Mr David
Nicals got our dinner went the mill come back to
Nicals stayed all night there ^{the rain} went in the morning

- 7 -ing to Joseph Nicals to see them came to Kingston
bought 4 lbs of castor oil for the mowing machine
paid 25 cent per lb got home to night, ^{for a pair of springs} paid 4 dollars
8 finished the hay rack attended a meeting of the
building committee William & Isabella come from
young grammar is no better

- 9 went to the funeral of Wm Moor he died on ^{day} ~~the~~
rain he was buried at Taylors there was 72 buggys &
waggons the Rev. Mr Corral preached a little ^{rain}

- 10 fixed or rather worked at the horse rake & went
to the school house & voted against a bye law for
to tax us for a macadamized road

- 11 fixed the mowing machine & got it ready. Geordy
& the girls went to Goranage to see the foundation stone
of a new Wesleyan Church laid

- 12 began to mow & mowed in the North west corner
field the grass is very light

- 13 mowed this forenoon went the funeral of Thomas
Davess daughter she died in Breckville she was buried ^{at Taylors}

- rain 14 finished cutting the corner field a fine shower this
afternoon raked a cocke some of the hay
