In the afternoon we went for a ride on the new street car line it is a belt line that goes about 12 around the fare was 25 cts. They have two cars and they are run by Sabine and they leave them standing on the main street at nights. Lettuce and Celery is the main crop here they plant the lettuce between the celery and cut it out first. they were cutting and shipping loads of it to New York. It is all irrigated here they have overflowing wells and they run it in to tiles and block up the ends. and when the wet weather is on they act as drains - as they take out the plugs and shut the water from getting in the tiles out of the wells. This town should be called the Celery town as there is acres upon acres of it - some of it is nearly ready to board up now. The land that is irrigated is worth about \$1000 an acre - but you go back in the bush - you can buy it for about \$50 to \$100 an acre - but think it would be worth quite a bit to get it in shape.
