**Claim Agent's Authority to Employ Doctor.**

In an action by a physician to recover for medical attendance upon an injured employee of the defendant street railway, on the ground that it had been authorized by the defendant's claim agent, evidence that the plaintiff had been paid by the defendant for the treatment of other injured employees brought to him by a former claim agent was held to be admissible, as showing the extent to which the defendant held out the authority of its claim agents, and as showing how far the plaintiff was justified in assuming that they had such authority.—*Pritchard vs. Old Colony St. Ry Co., Massachusetts Supreme Court, 103 N. E. 692.*
