- Mon July 23, Fine bright and moderately warm. Annie and Wylie's came home at noon. walked to Willie's in eve, they have no hay in.
- Tue July 24, Fine and quite warm. called at Mrs Smellies in afternoon they took me to see Thomas Poole in the evening.
- Wed July 25, Very warm. got a basket of cherries at Mrs Sniders 40 cents and Mrs Kane brought me a basket Tuesday a.m. before I was home. made wine, 5 lbs sugar 30 cts to a small basket.
- Thurs July 26, Fine and moderately warm got basket cherries from Mrs Snider 40, went for a drive to Unionville with Boyle girls. Siggie out for the night. a thunder storm in the night.
