Blue 15 Tin Kettle 10 Mending Boot 10 Hat 10 at the
Garden planted 50 hills of Cucumbers Immung
The Appletrees on Lower Point lots of Ice going Down
Lots of Wild Geese put a handle in the Hoe set some
Fires Keeping the Pet Lamb in the stable 9th
Fine E W Leander and Leander Went over to Lewis's Brough
Sugar and Milk Henry Bosell at the Fisherman
Digging the Potatoes ground Immung some of the
Appletrees Narcisse started for Lancaster with
Fish Leander fired 2 shots at Birds did not
Kill them 10th Ascension Day Foggy Thunder and
Lightning and Raining this Morning Fine Fencing East side
of the Garden Fence Planted 9 Rows of Potatoes sattered
the Cow on the Hill Point Immung some of
the Appletree at the Wet Place or Coal Pitt hill
Lots of Ice going Down 16 Rows of Potatoes Gave
Phillip a Plug of Tobacco 11th Fixing the Logs around
the Potato Piece Drove the Boats out of the Grove
12th Leander crossed to Sumnerstown Bought Threads
2 Dgs of Hooks 8 Eggs 4 cents paid Bought for Phillip
2 lb of Sugar 14 Plug of Tobacco, 15 cents paid 13th Went
to Lewis the Indian Leander and I windy 14th Piling
Rocks Back of the Barn Piling Manure 15th Leander
went to J. M. Dougalls stopt all night
Windy 16th Leander came got 2 Bushels Potatoes
bought them some to the owners planting of the
fisherman wants shanty cheaper

Planted a few Rows Rain Fencing Calves Pasture
at the Soap put up a stick at the Potato Piece
cleaning some in the Grove saved 2 Blocks of a
Log at the River 18th Fine Done making the Soap
9 Indians here wanting the Fisherman to pay
for the River J. M. Dougall and Anne here
gave Fisherman 2 Links of Store Pipes putting
up 2 sticks at the Door spreading some Manure
saved 18th Raining Windy went around the Island
Phillip the Fisherman Brought me 2 lbs of Tobacco
From Montreal 15.30 Cows broke the gate
last night Keeping the Pet Lamb in the calf
Pasture (Phillip came crisp on the card
some Ficks Roads came out Ice going Down 20th
Windy 21st Leander went to Charles Island for Wild Onions Bismarck
and John H. came Lewis and Wife came took Dinner
Gave Lewis a Binch of Matches Windy gave Bismarck a pair
of Sox 21st Leander cropt for the Mail Bought a paper of
Seeds Fencing Fence at the Barn Mosquitoes commenced and
Bullfrogs commenced to Talk some Ficks Ice going Down
22 Sold the cattle Digging in the Back place Burnt Brush
not very well Fixed the seat of the Boat 23rd Set
fire in the Marsh Back of the Sugar Bush Tin Warm
24th Mellen's Birth Day Fired one Volley only
Burning Brush in the upper Field 25th Went to
Sumnerstown seen Major Wiser on the Point
Bought a paper of Musk-melons 5 took eggs to
Hazzellens to exchange got a Bag of Potatoes
26th St Augustine Fire Rained Planted Potatoes Beans Melon
Beets Pumpkin The Fishermen paid to Jay Plum Trees
3 eggs to Blossom Lots of Ice went Down to Day
27th Jordan here Oscar Lafflesh here Lots of
Ice going Down
