Fine Printed 7 Rows of Potatoes in Hills taking
Boiling away working in the Garden planted
a Bed of Carrots 4 more Beds of onions and shallots
a Propeller went down taking Potatoes out of the cellar
and cleaning it 8th Fine & W Leander and Hugh Ann
Went to Covington Bought 9 lbs 10 5 gal of oil 163
Boots 1.25 Bought of Mr. C. Jeaff. Calico Bys 80
Yds 1 24 yds Lustre 25 6 Dollars Button 15 Cotton 15
Blue 15 Tin Kettle 10 Mending Boat 10 Flat 10 at the
Garden planted 50 hills of Cucumbers Trimming
the apple trees on lower Point lots of ice going down
Lots of wild Geese put a handle in the Hoe set some
Fires keeping the Pet Lamb in the Stable 9th
Fine E W Lema and Lema Went over to Lewis' Barn
Sugar and Milk Henry Bosell at the Fisherman
Digging the Potato ground Trimmed some of the
apple trees Narcisse started for Lanesville with
Leander Fired 2 shots at Birds did not
Kill them 10th Ascension Day Foggy Thunder and
Lightning and Raining this Morning Fine Evening East side
of the Garden Fence Planted 9 Rows of Potatoes dotted
the ground on the Hill Point Trimmed some of
the apple tree at the Wet Place or Coal Pitt hill
Lots of ice going down 16 Rows of Potatoes gave
Philip a Plug of Tobacco 11th Turning the logs around
the Potato Piece Drew the boats out of the groove
12th Leander crooked to Summerstown Bought Thread
2 lbs of Flour 10 5 cts 13th 3 cts paid Bought for Phillip
2 lb of sugar 14th Plug of Tobacco 15 cents paid 13th Went
to Lewis' The Indian Leander and I Windy 14th Piling
Raft Back of the Barn Piling Manure 15th Leander
went to Mr. Dougall's slept all night
Windy 16th Leander came got 2 bushels of Potatoes
brought them some Yards of onions planting at the
fisherman want Shanty cheaper

Mr. Miles Cameron Island 17th May 1888
Planted a few Rows Rain forcing calves pasture
at the soap put up a stick at the Potato Piece
cleaning some in the River saved 2 Blocks of a
Log at the River 18" Fine Done making the soap
Indians here wanting the Fisherman to pay
for the River Mr. Dougall and Annie here
gave Fisherman 2 Links of Store Pipe putting
up 2 sticks at the door spreading some manure
around 19th Raining Windy went around the Island
Phillip the Fisherman brought me 2 lbs of tobacco
From Montreal 15th 30 Cows broke the gate
last night keeping the Pet Lamb in the stable
Pasture Phillip came up on the cars
some ticks Toads came out ice going down 20th
Wet Sunday Hugh Ann Lavinia went to Charles Island for onions Bismarck
and John He came Lewis and wife came took dinner
gave Lewis a bunch of matches Windy gave Bismarck a pair
of socks 21st Leander crooked for the mail Bought a bag of Indian
seeds Fixing fence at the Barn Mosquitoes commenced and
Bullfrogs commenced to talk some ticks ice going down
22nd Sold the cattle Digging in the back place Burnt brush
not very well fenced the seat of the boat 23rd Set
fire in the Marsh Back of the sugar Bush in warm
24th Melen's Birth Day Fired one volley only
burning brush in the upper field 25th Went to
Summerstown seen Major Hunter on the Point
Bought a paper of Muskmelons 5 took eggs to
Hamilton to exchange got a Bag of Potatoes
26th St Augustine Tree Rained Planted Potato Beans Melon
Beets Pumpkins The Fisherman had to stay Plum Trees
begin to blossom Lots of ice went down to Dray
27th Gordon here Oscar LaFlesh here lots of
ice going down
