 put cement steps and platform. There are steam  
 hauling crushed stones from Gous to road  
 opposite our place. Willie cut some alfalfa at night.

 Willie finished cutting alfalfa No 1 W. in morning  
 then went for another load gravel. P.M. he cut  
 up alfalfa we took a small load in at night  
 we got two steps head cement at back door  
 today. Mr. Lass over at night milk .5.  
 We got butter cheque yesterday \$862

 Very dry weather.
