26 Ad & grandly drew 5 loads of wood out of a new area wood mostly small dead stuff

27 the boys brought out the horse power & saw & cut up the wood in the afternoon & set the horse power at the Barn for to cut the straw

28 began to cut the straw the cog wheel on the side of the mill & broke out 3 cogs we could no longer run more

29 Pease come to see Bennett she is dressed in a new dress & got a hole drilled in the axle of the mill

30 Rev Braumst preach this morning Mr Nicholson night
