## X=Rays as Evidence.

A witness who has qualified as an expert in the use of the X-ray and fluoroscope may be permitted to give the result of his observations, notwithstanding such observation discloses the shadow of the object, and not the object itself. X-ray photographs, skiagraphs or radiographs, which are no less representative of the shadow and not the substance, are properly admissible in evidence.—McCauley v. Chicago City Ry. Co., 163 Ill. App. 176.
