### X-Rays as Evidence.

A witness who has qualified as an expert in the use of the X-ray and fluoroscope may be permitted to give the result of his observations, notwithstanding such observation discloses the shadow of the object, and not the object itself. X-ray photographs, skiagraphs or radiographs, which are no less representative of the shadow and not the substance, are properly admissible in evidence.—*McCauley v. Chicago City Ry. Co.*, 163 Ill. App. 176.
