Fine sunny day warm. Mr Gass brought over some potato and planted a row West of mangels I made drills and Willie sowed turnips we got 24 rows sowed. Mary down town with Lucy in A.M got at Armstrongs groceries 85 sold eggs 44 got for butter 141 meat at Mills 25 cards 5 stamp 2 groceries 7cts 30. In P.M we spread bloods manure on No 1. Willie down town at night goods at Russell on aft \$2.24
