fine and warm clouding

fine and clear in the morning

looking like rain, wind
blowing hard, clearing off
in the afternoon. At night

Sr, drove out to Zion Church
we heard a lovely sermon
from the Book of Ruth, the
sermon was intersperced
with songs fitting for the
occasion after Church we
drove out thro the front Road

Sept 11th 1892

to Gavies, returning about
eleven o'clock altogether
we had a lovely time, noon
at Mr Hadley for tea tonight
and at Mr ^W Furthveys for
dinner.

fine but still very windy
some appearances of rain
wind blowing from the South
for a long while

Tue. 13.

fine pleasant morning, cloudy
over and commenced raining
about two or three o'clock P.M.
and continuing very steady
until nine o'clock. wind
very heavy wind sprung up
and blew a hurricane all night
making the old factory
jingle and howl like
something
