	21	<p>Tuesday Cloudy, strong east wind thawing a little. I hauled back load manure from box stall to S.L.; road over creek broke up. Willie helped Emory Ford to make new road through No 4. Willie went down in cutter in A.M. took 22 cts worth eggs to Armstrongs and got oranges lemons rice flour 1 1/2 gal coal oil on <del>the</del> got at Merwins on aft casting for seeds bats.</p>			
	22	<p>Wednesday Cloudy, thawing all day. Willie took 49 bushels and 1<sup>1/2</sup> lbs bats to Wilsons mill at 41 cts bushel \$20.30. In P.M. I took 54 bushels turnips down from pit to Beattie @ 12 cts \$6.48 got ticket for 3 loads sold previously 163 bushels @ 10 cts \$16.30 weighing 40. We hitched Luey and Jess in sleigh went around No 3.</p>		<p>2030 648 1630</p>	40
	23	<p>Thursday Fine sunny day thawing a lot roads bad. Father came up in morning with following from Eatons. 2 box fills 20 silk 38 expense 10. We went down in sleigh got 5 1/2 bag pulatoes from J. White \$5.30 for seed at Merwins sand paper &amp; rivet 15 harrows mended at Lemplins on aft 30. Took load manure back T.L. in A.M. got stuck with one in P.M. road so had too much water. Mrs. Carliss up for dinner and afternoon. I cut wood in brush in P.M.</p>			<p>68 530</p>
