15 Plowed on Pickering Township
 with one team. A M A's team helped at
 Flavin's with team. P.M. to clear out
 the new barn cellar. I got Horner
 Chief & Billy shot at Cedar Grove
 P.M. I took Susanna to Flavin's P.M.
 & brought her home again. I went to
 Range near Dearborn School house
 & caught a small mass of Chert. A
 W. very fine day. Flavin's Recd. Call
 Sunday 19 all went to Meeting at Hebron
 except I & Susanna. Sermon on Mt. Mt
 26 & 27 Co's by C. Guyman & B. C.
 Lord's Supper was celebrated. Visitors
 A's Henry, Adeline, Mary & Anne went to
 D.D.'s to supper. W. a drizzly rain & East
 wind all A.M. not heavy. Clear up
 after dinner. Slight rain P.M.
 28 A & Henry worked at Flavin's all day
 pulling out granary & building a
 wall in front of new Cellar. I
 took a great Chop to P.M. D's &
 brought a load of Maple lumber
 to Flavin's P.M. W. drizzly rain. All
 cleared up. P.M. fine & warm.
 29 A & Henry straightened posts & fixed fence
 along Dearborn Township west of home. A
 D. took Susanna to Hebron & left her
 they are to be there he went to Chert

to see H. White about some. I think
 the sheet pile we can get it at \$20.00
 per M. we do not know if we will take it
 W. Strong East. Wind pretty clear
 22 Boy Chord & worked in shop. A's Henry
 made 2 small stands. W. slow drizzling
 rain from East till about 4 P.M. I got some
 Mushrooms on Pickering & Dearborn Township
 a lot a lot on 5th Dearborn. Clear fog
 this evening very growing weather. The
 snow growing very fast. The grass is very
 large. The full wheat in north ground
 23 Henry helped Benj. fix fence. A big
 fixing old Wagon wheels. he is going to
 cut them down to make Trunks out
 of our old Wagon. I will bolt 1 inch
 maple on each side of the spokes
 I went to see Bishop. A.M. I took
 Butter & Eggs to Flavin's. A.M. I
 Nancy went to M. B. Bailey for some
 plants. P.M. W. very warm. I horse
 went around north P.M.
 24 Victoria day (so called in Memory
 of our late gracious Queen) a worked
 at fence till 4 P.M. after dinner I
 went to Cedar Grove. A.M. W. cloudy
 A.M. began to drizzle at noon drizzle
 nearly all P.M. a little cooler
 East wind
