Bar Keys to tell them that Abraham Smith's wife died last night & will be buried tomorrow I & Mary started after an early supper & went to Herman's to stay all night. W. rather cloudy P.M. Coat dried I got more Bonnie Phoebe at Cedar Grove P.M.

What Sunday 26 we staid at Herman's till after dinner then went to funeral of A. Smith's wife at Widdowson's, sermon by Br. C on 1st Book of Oseas by Br. C then at Denmark by the name of Henges Preached too we came home after the funeral W. drizzly & cloudy rather cool

What Monday 27 David's came to dinner then David & the boys went fishing to Kirkham's & the Kingston road got very few. Esther & the girls went looking for Mushrooms got some Flies & a little Eva came here P.M. W. very fine & misty while the morning

9 May 1901
Misses 13 work holders brought Aaron Weeber's wife & Isaac Gingrich's wife from Woolwich to supper

28 Boys planted Potatoes 34 drills in wet field behind Cicla's House A.M. A & Henry carried Potatoes out of Cellar P.M. I shot 3 Crows P.M. to put on the Corn W. rather cloudy I went to Cedar Grove A.M. & planted sweet Corn & some popcorn

29 A & Henry took fat steer to Lenoir A.M. I took Butter & Eggs to the store home with them we sold the Steer @ \$4.25 per Cwt. he weighed 1040 lbs A worked at Trucks P.M. I & Henry brought home some lumber & took some to Plowin from P.M. W. mild rain awhile A.M. cloudy P.M.

30 A worked at Trucks I & Henry shot 4 things then some fence along Denton's Rowline I & Mary went to Markham P.M. W. cloudy A.M. Clear while P.M. Clouded up as we came home rained very heavy before we got home did not get wet much

31 A worked at what Henry took our sheep went with Thomas & the marshes Home P.M. I went A.M. & got a great lot of wood to burn mostly in P.M. tonight's work
