Mon 27. Morrison came home from over the river got 10 dot from Benhardt when I went to feed the pig he would not eat. I was shipped up from the rain Arthur & his father came over. I we got him on the farm & he seemed quite a bit better. I churned & peeled a kettle of tomatoes for chile sauce.
Tue 28. Maggie called in say goodbye. Hattie took her in Chippawa when Mr. Drummond got her hat. Mrs. Rice called for onion. I made a custard pie & 9 apple pie cooked squash & beans & potatoes when one don't have meat. Hattie could not get Bologna & the butcher did not bring.
Wed 29. Schisler at Reesinger putting the concrete floor. Arthur helping. Hattie & I baked bread awful high wine. I churned & worked the butter.
Thurs 30. Hattie washed cold wine & dull. Had a young rooster for supper. Arthur in Reesinger all day made a rice pudding with raisins.
Friday October 1909
Friday 1 cold but sunshiny. They are getting out there potatoes 75 bushels. Margaret & I Sue helping. The teacher there in tea. I churned for our selves 2 lb 10 of oil up nearly all the last churning all but 2 lb. Hattie & I dressed. I made some more chile sauce. Gordon walked in Chippawa got 2 lb Bologna cold west wind.
Sat 2. cold but sunshiny one time in the day it was warm. Hattie made 4 squash pies. I cleaned all the boards & painted the yard. Made apple sauce from the wood fire. Hattie had 2 lb & 1 doz eggs. got 10 lb meat 25 c. canned. baked peaches basket of apples. Hattie got for her 1 lb shredded wheat. coal oil & done lead.

Sun 9. Arthur & the girls went in the truck & in Gaur's at night & Sunday school rally. We had the roast of beef Paul bought for dinner. I had a terrible headache & feeling the peaches out of cold water made it worse than usual. I peeled them last night never got in bed until eleven o'clock. ^{found them in the morning} Hattie & I had pig in the night.
Mon 4. canned the peaches: 1. 2 qt. for 23-2 glass jars churned after dinner 4 1/2 butter very nice day. Hattie took her curtains down & hung them out & washed her windows. Hattie went in the mill at Port-wick & basket for us 30 in the bushel. the tel-sponge at night. the made beef soup for supper.
Tue 5. fake dryer sale. Hattie & Hattie went he got a binder we wanted a cow. I baked the bread & the mixed it. I made two apple pies & apple sauce & made a slat on the wood house he clear it up & full filled up. Arthur in field Hattie cutting corn. when they went in the sale by Chippawa took 4 1/2 butter & 1 doz eggs got 50 sugar. the tea. & ginger cake soap. the beautiful day. I cleaned up the wood.
Wed 6. another grand day. Hattie & Hattie. all from the other house went but Hattie Maggie & I called. I churned & dressed a chicken for supper. Hattie washed the front room windows & pinned her curtains & put them up. Paul all covered with mud brought.
Thurs 7. such a beautiful day. Hattie & Hattie went after grapes 50 for us 12 for the children & a basket for Paul. went by Chippawa 2 lb 50 & eggs 18. 2 year 19 B. collar sugar 25 the change 25 for Margaret. La-hes 5 pepper & 25 of meat. Hattie & Arthur cutting marsh grass. I made 2 pies & a ginger cake. I am getting the cold today. I peeled a big batch of green potatoes & churned for our selves. Billa came from Buffalo Hattie took 2 lb
