

3 night. Hallie got home from Toronto. Mr Woodhead brought her from Chippawa. Mr Morrison in Wells for dinner our evening at the Wells.

Mon 27. Therefore came home from over the river got 10 dol from Bernhardo when I went to feed the pig he would not eat & was slumped up from the rain Arthur & his father came out & we got him in the barn & he seemed quite a bit better I cleaned & peeled a kettle of tomatoes for chili sauce

Tue 28. Maggie called in say goodbye. Hammie took her to Chippawa on her Drummondville got her hat Mrs Ries called for some potatoes when we don't have meat. Hammie could not get Roagins & the butcher did not come

Wed 29. Schuster at Recynger putting the concrete floor Arthur helping Marjorie baked bread awful high rising I churned & worked the butter

Thur 30 Marjorie washed cold water & dust. Had a young rooster for supper Arthur in Recyngers all day made a rice pudding with raisins

Friday October 1909

Friday! cold but sunshiny. They are getting out there potatoes. 75 bushel Marjorie 4 & Lee helping. The teacher there in tea. I churned for our selves 2 lb 10 oz of fat up nearly all the last churning all but 2 lbs. Marjorie & I ironed & made some more chili sauce. Gordon walked in Chippawa got 2 lb Colognia cold west wind

Sat 2. cold but sunshiny one time in the day I was warm. Marjorie went to Chippawa brought back 8 pounds of flour, made off sugar from the west sea. In tea she had 2 lbs 1 dog eggs. got 1 lb meat 25 weaners basket peaches basket pickles & Hammie got for her 1 can shredded wheat. coal oil & some lead

Sun 9. Arthur & the girls went to the brick & in Sarnia at night. Sunday school rally. We had the roast of beef Paul brought for dinner. I had a terrible headache peeling the peaches out of cold water made it worse than usual I peeled them last night never got in bed until eleven o'clock (found them in morning) Hills ever had big meal night

Mon 4 canned the peaches: 1 lb got for 73-2 qt for churned after dinner 4 1/2 bushels very nice day Marjorie took her curlans down hung them out & washed her clothes Well went to the mill at Port-wood 8 bushel for us 35 in the bushel. the set sponge at night she made beef soup for supper

Tues 5. fake dryers salt Well Marjorie went to get a binder, we wanted a cow. I baked the bread she mixed it I made two apple pies & apple sauce & made a start on the wood house he clear'd it up just filled up. Arthur & Fred Wells cutting corn. When they went by the salt by Chippawa took 4 1/2 bushels 1 dog eggs got 5 lbs of sugar. 1 lb tea. 5 ginger ^{honey} cak soap. 1 lb biscuit beautiful day. I cleared up the wood

Wed 6 Another grand day Well and Hair all from the other house went but Annie Maggie & Well called I churned & dressed a chicken for supper Marjorie washed the front room windows & aired her curlans & put them up. Paul all covered with mud brought

Thur 7 such a beautiful day Marjorie & Hammie went off Grapes 50 lbs for us 12 1/2 for the children & a basket for Paul went by Chippawa 2 lbs 50 lbs eggs 18. 2 ears 17 B. collar sugar 25 lbs clove 2 1/2 lbs Marjorie 1/2 lbs 5 pepper 5 lbs & 2 1/2 lbs of meat; Well & Arthur cutting marsh grass. I made 2 pies & a ginger cake. I am getting the cold Friday. I peeled a big batch of green tomatoes & chucked for ourselves. Billie came from Buffalo Marjorie taught me
