Infections of Fingers and Hands (Concluded)

4. The tendon should never be laid open from end to end as this procedure is almost certain to cause sloughing of the tendon.

5. If the tendon sheath is exposed and found distended with purulent or sero-purulent fluid, it should be freely drained.

6. If the whole tendon sheath is distended with pus it will be necessary to drain its upper end. Incisions for this purpose in case of the index, middle or ring fingers should be made in the palm of the hand directly over the tendon involved.—Garner; *Detroit Med. Journ.*
