 east wind

Monday 13 A Adeline Mary & Anne
 went to funeral of Peter R Hoover
 he was buried at Reynolds Hill this
 afternoon. Herriman was here to dinner
 we went with them I & Mary went
 with Thomas W. very fine & warm
 a cool wind. Strong wind last night
 Hitting Plowed down along East of dam
 with a furrow gang plow I Picked Apples
 A helped N B. Thresh I took 5 bags
 mixed grain to B. D. & went to Cedar Grove
 A m Flour & S. L. same were here P m I
 picked some Apples W. very fine & clear
 15 A helped N B. Thresh till about after
 dinner Henry gauged I took 4 bags
 wheat to Sprink & exchanged it for
 flour A m he gauged and till P m
 Henry & A spread along I & A
 Picked Apples awhile then we
 evening I took 6 bags Mixed grain
 to B. D. & leaving at home some Chip
 W. Coaler rather cloudy I sold
 an old Shropshire ram to H Yake

16 I & A
 dug Potatoes A B helped I Plowed them
 out & gauged a little between time they are
 great Chips but a good many rotten & cloudy
 a little drizzly this morning & P m

17 I & A
 Plowed they finished & I rolled
 Henry helped R Milroy thresh then they
