Four Common Types of Heart Disease—Nos. 2 and 3.

2. Syphilitic heart-disease.

Here the clinical manifestation is usually aortic regurgitation or aneurism, the characteristic pathologic lesion being syphilitic aortitis. Some cases of myocarditis are likewise syphilitic.

3. Arteriosclerotic heart-disease.

The clinical features are high blood-pressure with more or less marked sclerosis of peripheral arteries, often angina pectoris, signs of enlarged heart and various types of arrhythmia. This type occurs in elderly persons.—*Cabot; J. A. M. A.*
