Saturday Forward

Cold morning fine sunny day got warmer. N.S. up all day helping plant potatoes harrow cut wood etc. We finished planting potatoes in N.D. harrowed turnip land and I sowed phosphate & salt mixed balance of disked land except some complete fertilizer at top of field making a strip of phosphate up to top and complete fert. at each side at top. I made 32 drills using Kate & Mand left three rolls in box stall 14 drills complete fert rest phosphate except top as stated above. Willie sowed them with Derby and Good Luck 24 D. & 5 S. Willie finished fixing wheelbarrow and he and N. cut some wood saw on bank. Willie down town at night paid young Singer for pig feed \$29.00 cheque on R B he got ride down in auto with Day & son who were here to see about draining. He paid N.S. \$1.00 also 2 ct stamp for Singer cheque.
