Gynecological Hints.

Non-absorbent cotton is the best material from which to make vaginal tampons. Absorbent cotton, if used, will collect discharges and so lose its resiliency, while lamb's wool will frequently irritate the vagina, especially in cases of vaginitis. Heavy linen and silk thread are the best materials to use for strings on tampons.—Dr. R. Waldo; *Int. Journ. of Surg*
