May also up for P M went down again at 15

Wednesday

Rainy day. We did sundry jobs put up chop in AM Willie took it down PM met an auto just as he got out gate Kate reared a little. He brought Mary up with him Mother came back from Arthur to-day. We took Beatrice to forks at night.

Thursday

Rain last night and heavy at intervals in AM cleared off warm sunny PM very bad harvest weather. Willie took load stons we picked of No 4 down home then brought up chop paid for it 89cts also for 633 lbs barley dust got yesterday 760 I stoked some of No 7 stump field and finished No 1 PM. Willie plowed row No 7 7 I I dug some for anchor just No 6 G. St. at gate. Mary down town PM got both fixed got at Mills meat and lard 80 some 10 Amsting tea 20 fly paper 5 sent to Beausville for dog 3.00 Exp 5. got butter cheque lately 9.60
