MONDAY 10

1887

Peter and I worked in the woods this forenoon cutting wood and saw logs. Looked out to leave this afternoon to do some shopping for herself.

I have been down to Thomas Jacksons this evening to see him about going down to Pelham with me to morrow. He decided not to go however, so I will go alone.

Our trustees have had a number of teams drawing brick for the new school house to day. The roads are getting well broke again since the storm.

JANUARY

TUESDAY 11

1887

I started for North Pelham this morning at about eight o'clock; a severe South West wind and snow storm being in progress notwithstanding.

The storm being on my back I could manage to weather it and got along nicely. Reached Billy Stalls about at about sundown and went from there to David Hobbes where I am staying all night. Called over at Charles Stalls for an hour or so with James. Saw Mrs. Lawes, and was sorry to find that she had no help in the house.
