13. working in the garden planted onions, and sowed some
14. sowed mangolds, buto carrots, planted top onions paid 30. for 1 qt top onions, but seed 5 cts, I'll be ⁴⁵ 80
got boots for Mird 1.⁷⁵ shoes for Marion 1.⁰⁰ 2.75
15. Run fine day, I was not in church
16. Run, Marion & I went to the fore with the bulge and lamb. A heavy smoke hanging over the country
17. A fine day, got sugar 25 - ~~cent~~ Jimi Muddy at farm sent Holly & Betty to pasture. Presbytery met today McE ornick to Rockville 25
