6. Very fine day. heavy grey frost last night I was not in church today. Marion was vaccinated last week. it did not take. Dr Hunt & wife are off West to Chatham
7. Fine day Far went to Lancaster for lumber, paid Jimmy 2.24
8. Princes birthday I washed today. Sabbath School Pic Nic tomorrow going to William Campbells We got ½ barrel of herring at Willis Monday 3.25 - Lumber cost
9. It began to rain last evening and is still raining 7 P. M. the wind was very high all night and most of today 30 apples of our Dutchess fell off I think there is not 30 more on it
The Pic Nic was held in the Hall. I was not there
There was a present of some china dishes mounted on silver presented to Mrs Letcher
