It was quite nice we all went to Sunday school but Ada & Dwight I went up to church in the evening.

SATURDAY 17

(229-136)

It was quite a nice day I finished cutting the front field Robert ploughed 18. It was nice the children and I went to Sunday School and church Mr Warrens friends from Ottawa took the service there was a salvation army man and woman there.
