- " 17 Showery (Sunday) R. Thompson here. go May 1/2 night
- " 18 Warm. and Still. John Cultivating in 11. gin & harrow. Picking  
Stones in 11. (19th) Rain all day cleaned up Peas
- " 20 Rain all last night - clearing at daybreak. Finished plowing in 11. digging stones  
in 11. <sup>with fence station</sup>
- " 21 Warm. Finished stones on old fence station in 11. 2 Teams harrowing in 11.  
digging outlets of drains on R.Y. track Swallows
- " 22 Very Warm. Sowing Peas. Ben sowing oats in 11. Picking stones and  
Harrowing in 11. The first real good day since the seeding. John up at 5 o'clock
- " 23 Rainy morning. Took up load of Oak. John to 5. Belms Pressing Hay gin  
Harrowing. afternoon Bot. 2 Hives from Stan @ 1/56. @ 6 mos
- " 24 (Sunday) Cloudy. Damp. some showers. gin and May to 6. Men  
Maggie came with them.
- " 25 Damp. cool. 2 Teams plowing in D.F. May 1/2 to Fagus. Darky shed
- " 26 Rain last night - Thunder and 3 showers to day. plowing in 11. Field  
D. Milne plowing here in forenoon. Sand to most people. Stuffed for wet
- " 27 Fair cool. sowing Picking stones. Harrowing in 11. all the white grain sand  
in 11.
- " 28 Hard frost. thick ice leaving warm. plowing and discing in D.F. Took  
down Teams and up Hay. go. gin to Belwood. D. Super. Corn bot
- " 29 Heavy Rain and Thunder at daylight. Freezing on trees and fences  
in the morning. Took load of Oak to Fagus at B @ 32. 7 Bags chop
- " 30 The frost the ends blue looking. The ice is not done. Cant do any  
thing for wet. The month has been not at all for C. winds but much frost  
but raw and backward. Finished plowing for White Crop  
Started for Oranges. John for wood. A. and to Fagus. Cullis sale
- May 1 (Sunday) dull. damp. Misty at night. A. gin with 6. Men. John. May  
night. gin Harrows here. First Lamb
- " 2 Rain practically all day with 2 or 3 thunder storms. work at a stand  
= Still Country flooded. Cleaning out. Roof. Boase & Co. (Prepared)
- " 3 Fair cool. Took load of second wood. Snow jumps up - Hay. D. S. Night
- " 4 Frost. Ice. sunny dry day. snowdrifting field. Finished seeding  
of White Crop. 59 acres. 142 Bu Oats 12 Peas. 14 Days ahead last year
- " 5 Cold. Clear. drouthy day. Cultivating Root Land. Finished Harrowing. D.F.  
Leveling Jump Pile D. A. went to Blowing. John for Fagus. Wife is ill
