 Fine and Snowing Blowing not very cold Cropped Stopped  
 at Charles Rods. Mrs J. A. Cameron & Mary Cameron  
 came to see Charles Wife. Rod Cameron and  
 Smith the Inspector of Lighthouses at Hamiltons  
 John and his Wife away Charles and up to  
 the Store he brought Frank Laplante 2 Bags of Potatoes  
 Bought of Vepond 1 plug of Tobacco paid this seen at  
 Summers John all Spring he came over with  
 Dick Nicholson and his Son heard P. Baker  
 was a going to Nevada Frank Laplante a Bee at  
 the Boat to Day wanting more timbers for it  
 yet old Mr Vepond up there is some talk  
 of them selling out to one Stuart Races in  
 Hogansburgh A. J. Baker and Dunlop went  
 Jim Grant cropped with 2 Sticks of Elm to kill for a  
 Ride down with Charles Rose took Dinner there  
 Frank wanting the Loung the stick dont  
 want to Buy it and he come down tomorrow  
 to see it a great deal of Travelling on the ice  
 to Day Frank Laplante lost his Case on the ice  
 crossing Broke 1 of the screwdracks 6<sup>th</sup> Snowing  
 Blowing cold some 7<sup>th</sup> a very fine warm Day  
 8<sup>th</sup> I cropped wrote a Letter for J. Hamilton took  
 Dinner went up to the Store got some Papers  
 from Cornwall Stopt at Charles Rods till  
 it was 12 o'clock Mr. Crammon at John  
 Hamiltons Mr. Reynolds here took away  
 Rosby 12<sup>th</sup> Gordon went for the oil 16<sup>th</sup> Stopt  
 John Hamiltons their stove pipes took fire  
 Bought 1 plug of Tobacco sent a Paper to Charles  
 seen Mrs Rose got a Hooker or 2 Wm Kenney  
 wife a young Daughter yesterday 17<sup>th</sup> for don  
 went to Hamilton John came down with 2 Bags  
 of Potatoes and took up My Ashes 11 Bushels  
 Bought of Vepond an Box 1 lb Tea 65<sup>th</sup> 2 Dgs of Herrings 30<sup>th</sup>  
 2 yds of Towelling 40 pair of Races 25<sup>th</sup> 3 yds Calico 35<sup>th</sup> That's  
 2<sup>nd</sup> 15 and the Ashes is 1.65 I give 54 cents on this came down  
 to Johns took supper speaking to Charles about the sheep

Mr. Wm. Cameron March 12 1875  
 Soft to Day Thinning on this Day the Month  
 Master First came to the Island and the ice  
 opened on this Day of the month that year which  
 was very early one of the White sheep had a Lamb  
 yesterday a Black Lamb or spotted Lewis Bosell up yesterday  
 over at the Raising of the Prime Lewis Thinking Charles  
 Rose would come to Day 13<sup>th</sup> I cropped John Hamilton and  
 Charles Rose at the Funeral of one of the Boys in the  
 Conception Bought of Vepond 1 plug of Tobacco (Bows) cent  
 on the plug got the Promise of 100 Wt of Flour from  
 I Grant as Vepond would not give it to me its to  
 come to night from Lovington Stopt at J. Hamiltons  
 took supper there got 3 Pieces of Pork from Ian  
 Cold East Wind but warmer in the Evening I Grant  
 sending his Car Load of Wheat over to Lovington  
 to get Ground heard John Sessima got seized  
 for Suggling coal out from the Stateside lost  
 his Horses heard the Prime was up 28 Feet yesterday  
 Gordon fixed a covering over the sheep 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday Preaching  
 on the Front a change in the Moon First Quarter after 8  
 about this time the Wind raised a Morning Change Mercury Stationary  
 in the sign of the Bull seen 2 Crows to Day for the first this Winter  
 Nicholsons Drawing their Ice yesterday to their ice house  
 15<sup>th</sup> went to the Bush to see the Elm Logs too & the snow  
 of them snow very deep in the Bush a Fine Day thawing  
 took the square spit of the Bush 16<sup>th</sup> I cropped got 25 lbs  
 of Flour from I Grant water on the ice <sup>12<sup>th</sup> Lamb</sup> seen the  
 Munk track came back on his old track The Sale out in the  
 Gore to Day Mr. Gillis and John McPhersons kind of Fine to Day  
 17<sup>th</sup> St Patrick and he is like Wildfire to Day Storm  
 Blistering cutting stove Wood one of the sheep 2 Lambs today  
 18<sup>th</sup> Drifing cold Raw Day 18<sup>th</sup> got 2 Horses down at  
 the Sturgeon Island near the Point skinned them to night  
 Thawing them out all Day 20<sup>th</sup> First Day of Spring  
 East Wind cold and Stormy I cropped J. Hamilton Broke Key  
 and I took home the Gentlemen Pig John and I went  
 to I Grants got 100 Wt of Flour from the Old Lady as I'm  
 as not at home Vepond would not give it to me Matched Pig
