Russell's handkerchiefs 35 Phillips goods \$1.30
at Steels a/c dry goods \$10.50. Willie drove
town at night. got Delinicator 15 cts

Steels goods 57 Buttons 37 Pliers 10. I went to school meeting
at night and was elected trustee. I was on
adjourned meeting from morning. Spred the turkeys No 2
