

Mr James Cameron Island 10th August 1850
Mr Gene went off 11th Mowing and
making coals Leander to Hamiltons
for yeast John mine came no board
12th Gene Bohemian went up
Mowing Mr Gene came going
to Cornwall with wool to his Daughter
left me a great & Wind 13th Bohemian
went down Fishermens Wife Daughter
and 2 children went off Began
a stack put 119 coals in it to Day
not finished yet Lewis children here
for butter and Bread the fatness
went up and down to Day Hugh
went to Dundee the small owl head
gimmied some apple trees 14th Gene
cutting hay put more hay in the
stack Phillip came John mine
here told us he found Frances
over below Frasers last week
15th Mowing finished Below the
house Hugh Ann came from Dundee
Bought of John 740 Pork 32 Glass
1 gallon of Vinegar 40 Powder 20
Cacao 35 Found out about our Boat
16th Leander and I went to look for
the Boat and found it hid in
the Marsh at Murdoch McDonalds
took our Lunch on Buchann Island
Gene made 60 coals not Raked
Bought of I Summers matches 12
17th Rain Windy Lewis Boys here

Mr James Cameron Island 18th August 1850
Fine Mowing in the upper field
Raking made some coals 19th cold
Bismarck's B Day 1870 put
in 50 coals stuffed the east end of the
Barn put 2 Loads on the Barn floor
commenced to Rain and cold high
East Wind Sharrons Barge sailed
up cut some in upper field
& whermens sline all broke
got fast in Logs 20th Mowing
above the Lane Tuninghay took up the Row
of Potatoes from the East Piece let in
the Mare to eat below the house Fine
21st & Wind changed to South Wind
very high with Rain Mowing
in the upper field about 22
minutes to 1 This Morning heard
a rumbling noise like an
earthquake sounded West going
22nd Mowing in the Brush in the
upper field sawing Dulting frame
4 of them taking Buds of Tobacco
Windy 23rd Gene Began to Rain
high & Wind cold Put some hay on
the Barn floor grew a Bung of Wood
those Indian Thieves is around Trowling
camped at the head of the Island 24th
Mowing Windy 25th Mowing
in upper field Fine The coals
milked to Day by those campers
John H and Linnia to Plum Island
